



## PREPARING FOR YOUR WARMSWORTH FIREPLACE

The following preparations should be carried out before your Warmsworth fireplace fitters arrive.

1. Any previous fireplace should be completely removed unless otherwise arranged.
2. If Warmsworth stone is removing the existing surround any gas appliances should be disconnected, and ornaments removed from the mantle.
3. Any pictures or mirrors that are hung on the chimney breast should be taken down.
4. Wall and floor preparations and any inglenook preparations should be completed leaving surfaces as flat as possible, unless otherwise arranged.
5. Gas pipes (if required) should be in the correct location within the center of the opening, either behind the wall line for an inset fire or towards the back of the inglenook area if we are fitting an inglenook.
6. As much furniture as possible should be moved out of the room and any furniture still within the room should be moved away from the fireplace area and covered with dust sheets.
7. All walls should be plastered prior to fitting the fireplace.
8. Skirting boards around the fireplace area must be removed.
9. All carpets should be rolled back away from the fireplace.
10. Warmsworth Stone will not be liable for cutting carpets to size or refitting skirting boards.
11. A route for the fitters to come in and out of the house should be planned.
12. It may be necessary to cut stone on site, this creates a lot of dust, an area should be made available for the fitters to do this (outside if possible).
